



TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. The competition is opened to:
 - 1.1.1. All local and international undergraduate students from any field of study.
- 1.2. Each participating team may send a **maximum of three (3) team members and one (1) advisor/chaperone** to the competition.
- 1.3. All team members from the same team must represent the **same educational institution**.

2. COMPETITION

- 2.1. Only **one innovative product** is allowed for each participating team. The team must prepare **presentation slides** for the innovative product.
- 2.2. The competition consists of **three tracks/categories**:
 - a) Environment/waste treatment/biotechnology
 - b) Renewable energy/biofuel
 - c) Green building/green technology products
- 2.3. There are **two rounds** of this competition.
 - 2.3.1. The 1st round involves presentation of the innovation products of all participants groups from all categories. The question and answer (Q&A) sessions will be conducted by the panel of judges.
 - 2.3.2. The 2nd round **ONLY** involves 3 selected teams of each category from the 1st round. The selected teams will do slide presentation in this round.

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- 2.4. Every participating team must prepare and present their innovative product, based on the following details:
- 2.4.1. **Objective** of the innovative product
 - 2.4.2. **Materials** used for making the innovation product
 - 2.4.3. **Method/development** for preparing the innovation product
 - 2.4.4. **Impact** of the innovation product
 - 2.4.5. **Challenges** in making the innovation product
 - 2.4.6. **Ways to improve** the innovation product
- 2.5. The innovation product must be **original, creative and related to the theme** of the competition which is ***“Toward a Green and Sustainable Society”***.
- 2.6. The innovation product will be judged based on the following criteria:
1. Originality and creativity of the idea proposed (new idea or adaptation of idea).
 2. Design of the innovation product (materials used, user friendly, accuracy of information).
 3. Impact of the innovation product (individual, community, economy, green environment).
 4. Improvement of the innovative product (can be improved, problems can be overcome).
 5. Presentation (the use of visual, oral communication and effective public speaking, detailed presentation, punctuality).



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- 2.7. The **cost** for preparing of the innovative product will be **fully covered by the participating team**.
- 2.8. The organizer reserves the right to refuse any entry which does not meet the eligibility requirements, objectives and rules of this competition.
- 2.9. Internet access **will not be provided**. All participating teams are advised to bring their own mobile broadband or other devices for easier internet access.
- 2.10. The appointment of the panel of judges for this competition is the sole responsibility of the organizer.
- 2.11. All decisions made by the judges are **final and appeal is not allowed**.
- 2.12. The winning teams from each of the categories will receive medal, cash prize and certificates.
- 2.13. The **Best of the Best Innovation** team will be awarded with **cash prize and certificates**.
- 2.14. **Best Presenter (one person)** will receive cash prize and certificate.
- 2.15. Every participating team will receive **participation certificates and plaque**.
- 2.16. By entering the competition, all participating teams agree to the possible inclusion of their innovation product in **any media coverage** by the organizer and the sponsors, such as press releases or publications.

6. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORTATION

- 6.1. All participating teams are required to complete the **Section E – Accommodation & Transportation** in the registration form. The pick up points are at CIQ (Johor Bahru Customs, Immigration, and Quarantine Complex) and Senai Airport only.
- 6.2. Any amendment or cancellation regarding accommodation or transportation should be informed to the organizer **at least two weeks before** the competition.
- 6.3. Only **registered participants and chaperones** who applied for accommodation and transportation will be provided with both facilities.
- 6.4. Transportations **will not be provided** to the participants who arrived exceed the time stated in the registration form. Refer (**Section E – Accommodation & Transportation**). However, UTM delivery number will be provided and participants are advised to download Grab or Uber applications to get transportation easily.
- 6.5. All participants must be at the selected pick up point 30 minutes before the pick up.
- 6.6. Any participants who arrived late for accommodation check-in will be compound.
- 6.7. For those participants who arrived by their own university transportation service, accommodation will not be provided for their driver unless stated in registration form in (**Section E – Accommodation & Transportation**).
- 6.8. Participant will be penalized if she/he is found to be responsible for the damage done to UTM properties during the stay.
- 6.9. **BEFORE THE COMPETITION DAY:**
 - 6.9.1. Transportation will not be provided for any off - campus location before the day of event.
