


3. To visit the series of independently developed ultrasound medical instruments, etc.





Traditional Chinese Medicine

Course introduction

1. To recognize common medicinal plants, learn the traditional identification experience and the modern identification methods of crude drugs, research and explore theoretical and practical issues such as authenticity identification of crude drugs;
2. To learn the four diagnosis of diseases in traditional Chinese medicine, such as look, listen, question and feel the pulse;
3. To learn and experience the non-pharmacological acupuncture and cupping.

3. To learn the basic skills of Prosthodontics by clinical practice, video recording, imitating head mold and model operation.




