




IN CHONGQING, CHINA

Package A HIFU Technology

- 1. To visit HIFU Technology Centre, including comprehending its development process, scale and current situation, as well as national status;
- 2. To watch the experiment of local high temperature caused by ultrasound focusing;
- 3. To visit the series of independently developed ultrasound medical instruments, etc.





Package B

Mass Spectrometry Workshop

- 1. To learn the basis of mass spectrometry technologies applied to Medical research;
- 2. Hand-on experience on biological sample preparation, mass spectrometry operation, data extraction, and statistical analysis.





Package C Traditional Chinese Medicine

- 1. To recognize common medicinal plants, learn the traditional identification experience and the modern identification methods of crude drugs, research and explore theoretical and practical issues such as authenticity identification of crude drugs;
- 2. To learn the four diagnosis of diseases in traditional Chinese medicine, such as look, listen, question and feel the pulse;
- 3. To learn and experience the non-pharmacological acupuncture and cupping.





Package D Prevention of Oral Diseases

- 1. To visit the CQMU Hospital of Stomatology;
- 2. To learn about Dental caries, periodontal disease, oral cancer, sensitive dentin, dental trauma, acid erosion, and malformations, including their risk factors and preventive measures;
- 3. To learn the basic skills of Prosthodontics by clinical practice, video recording, imitating head mold and model operation.

- 1. To visit the Second Affiliated Hospital of CQMU, including its history, heritage and development;
- 2. To observe smart healthcare;
