 - I. University Students: Year 1 & Year 2 International students currently enrolled in a bachelor's degree program in Taiwan.

 - II. International High School Students: Grade 11 (juniors) who are non-R.O.C. citizens attending an international school in Taiwan. Admission is based on school recommendation only. Each school is invited to nominate up to 3 students.

5. **Dates:** March 25 (Friday)- March 26 (Saturday), 2022
6. **Primary language of instruction:** English
7. **Location:** National Taiwan University
8. **Application Deadline:** 11:59 PM, March 10 (Thursday), 2022
9. **Admission Decision:** March 14 (Monday), 2022 via e-mail. Accepted applicants are to complete registration and payment within two days. Waitlisted applicants will be notified when an opening becomes available.
10. **Fees:** NT\$1,000 (Non-fundable except force majeure events)
