Fluent in English (**The language used in this seminar will be English, which requires the participants to possess decent English ability for conversation purposes. Please ensure you have a good degree of English fluency prior to registration**). Total of 140 applicants will be selected to participate and another 30 will be placed on the waiting list.
2. We will provide participants of this seminar accommodation on 18<sup>th</sup> Oct. if their schools or workplaces are located **south of Hsinchu City, Eastern Taiwan or outlying islands**. Details will be arranged by the organizer.
