Writing Contents

- 1. A story in English. Word limit: 500.
- 2. A title that suits the content of the story.
- 3. 3 photos that relates to your story. Photos that can further

express your feeling and emotion are highly recommended.

4. Both stories and photos should be made by the students themselves without the help of others, and should not be published openly.

Prize:

- Top Award: 3 winners will be awarded with a certificate of recognition and convenient store coupon equivalent of 8000NTD, 3000NTD and 2000NTD according to their ranking.
- Selected Award: 2 winners will be awarded with a certificate of recognition and convenient store coupon equivalent of 1000NTD according to their ranking.

Evaluation standard: Content 40%, Innovation and Fun 30%, Picture 30%

Evaluation process: Three experts will evaluate the works and decide which pieces won the prizes.
