Peptide New Drugs for Osteoarthritis developed in KMU



In September, Orthopaedic Research Center in KMU successfully developed peptide new drugs for early treatment of Osteoarthritis (OA), inhibiting articular cartilage degradation and death. The new results were awarded with 4 million U.S. dollars for successful technology transfer, the largest scale recently.
