MONGOLIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences (MNUMS) is one of the leading state universities in Mongolia. Since its establishment in 1942, MNUMS has nurtured 90% of health professionals in Mongolia who are working now in health care service throughout the country.

The university has 5 schools including School of Medicine, School of Pharmacy and Biomedicine, School of Dentistry, School of Public Health and School of Nursing and 3 branch colleges (Darkhan-Uul Medical College, Govi-Altai Medical College and Dornogobi Medical College) with 600 faculties and 13'000 students in total.

In 2012, "Association for Medical Education in the Western Pacific Region" certified that "The MNUMS's medical education program curriculum met the accreditation guidelines set forth in the Global Standards for Basic Medical Education (AMEWPR Specifications) of the World Federation of Medical Education.

Based on our long history, rich experiences and well trained faculties, we are aiming to become one of the top 100 universities in the Western Pacific region of Asia between next few years. In order to achieve this goal, we are making constant efforts to improve the training quality with the study environment.

MEMBERSHIP WITH EXCELLENT TEACHING

All level of training: MNUMS provides undergraduate and postgraduate programs in medicine, dentistry, traditional medicine, pharmacy, public health, biomedicine, physical therapy, nursing, midwifery and health technology fields.

Faculty with strong career experiences: the university has 113 faculty members whom are defended their graduate degree in abroad. Especially in the last few years, many faculties sent to Japan and Korea to our sister universities to defend their degree in different research fields.

Open University: university provides online training courses on 44 subjects. Due to vast territory of Mongolia, e-learning and e-training is the one of the main priorities of our development goals.

RESEARCHES IN MNUMS - CREATING NEW KNOWLEDGE

The prime objective of any university is the advancement of knowledge; through research on the one hand and teaching on the other. Therefore, our university's research priorities are as follows:

- Promoting health services and researches using bio, nano, IT and chemical technological advances in the diagnosis, treatment, prevention of diseases.
- Conduct gerontology, genomic, cancer biology, stem cell, genomics and proteomics researches.
- Transfer the Transplantation technology by multiple stages
- Strengthening maternal and child care by improving Food safety through studies on nutrition and epidemiology of NCDs, vaccination, environmental health and behavior.
- Advancing Traditional medical researches to develop new diagnostic, treatment methods and develop new medicinal drugs and its production technology.

GLOBAL MNUMS

Global network: MNUMS has made exchange agreements with many foreign universities so that faculty and students can actively seek international exchanges and joint research efforts.

Our international cooperation mission is to facilitate health research, education and collaboration among MNUMS faculties, students and our global partners for the benefit of patients worldwide. We look to accomplish this by: facilitating international exchanges among students, residents, faculty and staff, promoting and facilitating international research efforts, especially those associated with medical education and initiating and fostering international collaborations. Currently it has established partnership via exchange agreement with about 144 universities and organizations from 24 countries and regions thus cultivated a worldwide network for academic exchange and collaboration.

THE UNIVERSITY THAT CARES

Students associations and clubs: Over 90 clubs and associations are working effectively at the Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences. Our students' energy is boundless, proving their dedication in and out of the classroom. Some of them work specialized fields such as microbiology, pathophysiology, cardiology, pharmacology, public health, dental surgery and others fields while they are in undergraduate program. Other student clubs provide a wide range of activities for self development and social work. These clubs have included journal clubs, lectures, workshops, charities and university festivals in the past.

Sport activities: It is our university's belief that a good doctor must also habitually practice a healthy lifestyle, and therefore we encourage this attitude among our students. In order to promote physical activity, students have regular courses for basketball, volleyball, table tennis and others.

Central Medical Library: The Central Medical Library (CML) is the only and largest medical library in Mongolian health education and provides not only students (undergraduate, graduate, postgraduate) but teachers, doctors and other professionals in the medical field with books and learning materials on medicine and health.

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MONGOLIAN NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES

UNIVERSITY GENERAL HOSPITAL

University general hospital was established in 25 May, 2007 as an outpatient clinic with departments of gastroenterology, endoscopy, neurology, radiology and diagnostic imaging. In 2011, it has been accredited by City Health department accreditation commission, to provide the qualitative health care through our professors and faculties.

Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences plans to build a University Teaching Hospital with financial assistance from the Japanese Government. The University Teaching Hospital offers 150 beds and has following departments, including pediatrics, internal, obstetrics & gynecology, neurology, surgery, emergency and radiology and general laboratory with high standard equipments. We plan to establish the University Teaching Hospital in 2017. The purpose of establishment of this hospital is to prepare the best doctors, nurses and other health professionals who can provide population with world standard health care service.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

Graduate Training Center

The Graduate Training Centre was founded in 2003, when the Mongolian National Medical University was expanded as the Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences. The Graduate Training Center offers graduate programs in field of Medicine, Public Health, Traditional Medicine, Dentistry, Biomedicine, Nursing, Pharmacy and clinical areas.

MASTER PROGRAM

We offer a master's graduate course which is a two-year (33 credits) full-time training program in 49 specialized areas. The main goal of Master's course is to capacity building of the graduate students in the medical sciences through scientific method, together with a solid scientific and operative preparation in the chosen field of specialization.

Since 2006, our university is offering 1.5 year training program in Master of Public Health. From this year, School of Public Health is broadening its master program by offering Master of Environmental & Occupational Health, Master of Health Management & Economics field for 1.5 years training program.

DOCTORAL PROGRAM

PhD programs (generally three years, 64 credits) in 163 specialized areas are open to graduates and consist of supervised scientific research supported by a combination of general and more specific courses. All professional training programs combine preclinical and clinical works with seminars, literature review discussions and self-study.

POSTGRADUATE TRAINING INSTITUTE

Mongolian National University of Medical Sciences – the main clinical teaching and training center with a wide range of Postgraduate Medical Education Programs comprises more than 70 accredited Specialty and Subspecialty Programs, Science Degree Programs and Programs on Continuing Education in the Health Professions.

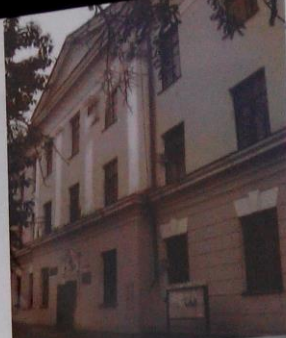

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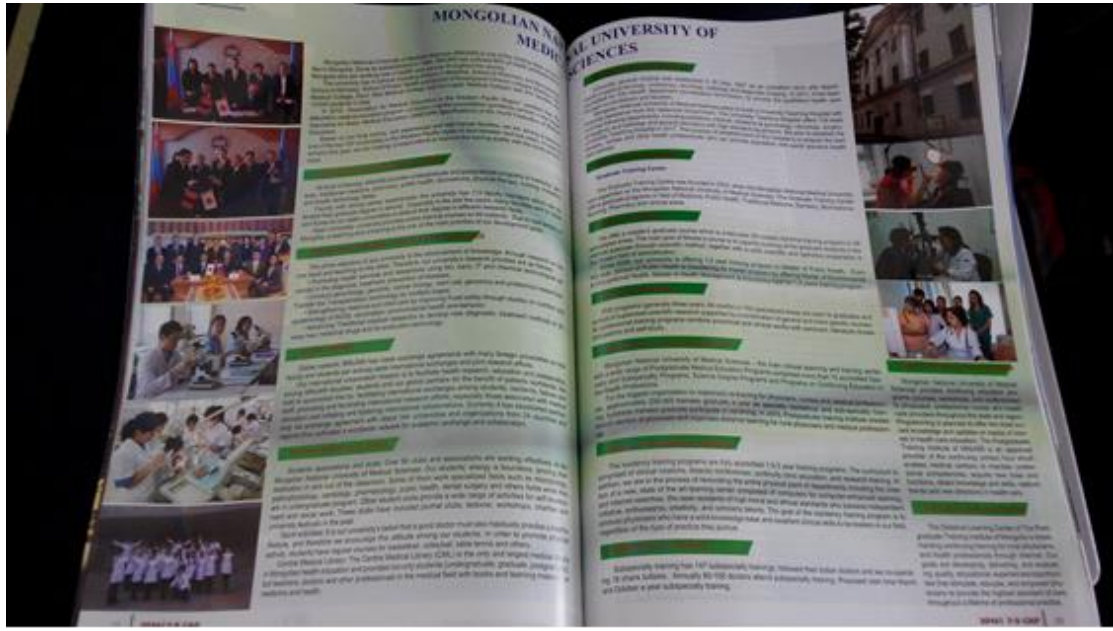


CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM

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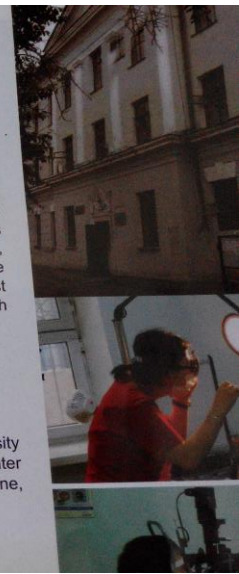
